

How to use this ring finger sizing tool:

- 1. Cut out the black figure shown above. (We have included several copies so that if you make a mistake, you won't have to print out another page.)
- 2. Using a small blade, cut the slit on the fat end marked by the vertical white line.
- 3. Wrap the strip around the base of your ring finger, and insert the narrow end of the strip into the slit. Do not wrap too tightly or loosely.
- 4. Mark the point on the narrow end where it comes through the slit.
- 5. Measure the length between the slit and the mark you made on the narrow end of the strip in millimeters. This is the circumference of your ring finger.
- 6. Use the ring size calculators at https://www.had2know.com/lifestyle/us-ring-size-chart-calculator.html https://www.had2know.com/lifestyle/uk-ring-size-chart-calculator.html to find your equivalent ring size in the US or UK system.

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
